Alfredo's story

"I feel more like a leader helping someone else out."

Alfredo wanted to make sure all 3 of his mentees were being supported in a way that worked for them. One of them wanted very frequent meetings - every two weeks. One of them wanted to reach out only when they had a question. And another wanted more frequent communication at the start of the relationship, but less frequent as time progressed. Though their meetings were all different, Alfredo was able to help his mentees set goals and achieve them. He even helped one of his mentees find a job they were excited about.

Nadia's story

"[My mentee] seems to be enthusiastic at the start and end of our phone call, which seems like a good indicator that the support, even if for a few minutes, is helpful for her reflection and positivity."

Nadia's mentee wasn't sure what kind of support she was looking for at the start of her mentorship. But after some guidance from Nadia, realized she didn't have specific academic or career goals, but recognized the value of them. They decided to check in monthly over the phone just to catch up and talk through any questions that arose between calls. This more informal structure worked for the both of them.

Hi Ezra,

Uplift University mentors have diverse backgrounds and expertise. **So how does Mentor Collective choose the right mentor for you?**

- Both mentors and mentees take a matching survey.
- In the survey, you'll be asked about:
 - *Your field of study*
 - *Your career goals*
 - *Your life experiences (including challenges)*
 - *Your personal interests*
 - *Your linguistic background*
 - *Your ideal mentor's age*
- You can tell us which of these matters most to you, alongside anything else you'd like us to know.
- A "matcher" carefully reads your answers, combs through the profiles of available Uplift University mentors, and makes the closest match.

NOTE: We know firsthand that matching students and mentors is an art, not a science. If you feel like the mentor we pick for you isn't the best match, let us know so we can look for a better one!
