Matching Process:

· Once matched, you will both decide how you want to connect: text, email, video call, or in-person. We recommend you connect with your mentee at least once per month.

Program Timeline:

· This mentorship program will end in Spring of 2026, but you're more than welcome to stay connected with your mentee after the official end of the program.
